A FEW USEFUL TIPS!

How to spot a phishing email:

- Unexpected messages requesting sensitive information OR advising of a change to sensitive information (like passwords, account numbers, or payment details).
- Urgent or threatening language pressuring you to act quickly.
- Suspicious links or attachments.
- Sender addresses that look unusual or slightly misspelled.

Best practices to stay protected:

- Never click on suspicious links or download unknown attachments.
- Do not share login credentials or personal information via email.
